

Authors and Presenters are individually responsible for all fees and will be billed.

AUTHORS

- SPESIF expects a non-returnable fully paid registration to accompany the final camera-ready manuscript for it to be published in the SPESIF-2010 AIP Proceedings.**
- Each additional manuscript publication requires an editorial fee of \$275 and is due with the camera ready manuscript submission.
- The page limit is 15 pages. A fee of \$100 per page over the 15 page limit will be required regardless of page size. The editorial chair has the option to reject manuscripts over 15 pages.
- The billing author is the first author regardless of the presenter or the submitting person. However, payment can be paid by third parties.

** Should a final camera-ready manuscript be submitted without payment, it is assume that the author wishes it published. Therefore, the author will be billed the full registration fee, regardless of attendance. This generally applies to authors in organizations that typically do not pay fees until the forum. To avoid miss-understandings, please inform IASSPES if this applies at the time of final camera-ready manuscripts submittal.

Additional Editorial Fees

- A minimum fee of \$50 will be billed for editorial services rendered after draft manuscript approval, if pulled by the author before the final draft submission; regardless of the reason. The full amount of this editorial fee will depend on the amount of time the editorial staff spends on your manuscript. Following the manuscript guidelines will reduce the editorial time spent on your manuscript. - If unsure of your manuscript, work with the session chair(s) before submitting the first draft manuscript. This fee will be waived for a minimum one day registration.
- An editorial fee of \$275 will be billed for manuscripts pull by the author from AIP publication after the submission of the final draft; regardless of the reason. The final draft is the draft sent back to the author with the request for the final camera ready manuscript. This fee will be waived for full registration.

NON-PAPER PRESENTERS

- SPESIF expects a minimum non-returnable one day paid registration to be paid no later than 30 days before the forum for those person giving presentations with no paper. Full registration is required to attend more than one day.
- Authors paying full registration may do an additional non-paper presentation at no additional charge, pending room availability.

INVITED/GUEST LECTURERS

- Invited or guest lecturers are not required to pay a registration fee for their speech/presentation.

- Invited or guest lecturers may submit papers related to their speech/presentation, but the minimum editorial fee of \$275 will apply. Page charges may be waived in special cases.
- Non-related papers or presentations may require addition fees per above.
