BIO SUBMISSION

Bios should be named as (Name)_bio.doc Example: Robertson_bio.doc

Submit all bios to the following address: bio2010@ias-spes.org

Abstracts, submitted to the *Space, Propulsion & Energy Sciences International Forum* are to be in Microsoft Office Word 2003 or 2007 format.

Most Universities and colleges can get MS Office at a reduced cost at their book store. Plus there are several academic online sources (Example: <http://www.academicsuperstore.com/>).

Note that there are several versions of MS Office 2007 at different costs, all of which include MS-Word, but may not include other desirable software. PowerPoint is the preferred presentation software.

GENERAL FORMAT GUIDELINES

The following provide some specific guidelines that are to be followed:

Font

Font Type: Times New Roman

Professional/Nick Name

Spacing: 0pt before and 18pt after
Font: 18pt/Centered
General: May use titles (Prof., Dr. & etc.) and after names (e.g., JR, II & etc)
Nicknames are optional and should be place in prentices under legal name; 14pt/Centered.

Address/Affiliation/Phone/Email

Spacing: 0pt before and 18pt after
Font: 10pt/Italic/Center
General: Use of either your affiliation or home address is acceptable.
Use of either your affiliation or home phone is acceptable.
Use of either your affiliation or home email is acceptable.

Bio

Spacing: 0pt before and 18pt after
Font: 11pt/Justified

Bio Information

The information in your bio should only be concerned with your professional career. Paragraph and list forms are acceptable, but paragraph is preferred.

Author Picture

Please include a picture in your bio. Embedded with the text is preferred. If acceptable to AIP, these bios will be included in the AIP proceedings CD for both authors and presenters.

High quality pictures may be sent separately for us to resize and place in the text.
